Background: Over time, discussions about spiritual gifts have led to terrible church controversies and confusion. It can be a mine field, so be aware!

Maturing in our Christian walk requires an understanding of what spiritual gifts are, what they are not, and how to grow in them in a balanced and biblical way.


You Are Unique! and Uniquely Designed • Created with a Purpose READ Psalm 139:13-16 and Jeremiah 1:5 Study Points:

SPIRITUAL GIFTS ARE ...

- 1) NOT natural talents, but can complement them.
- 2) NOT given to just the elite.
- 3) NOT signs of spiritual maturity.
- 4) NOT the fruit of the spirit. **READ Gal. 5:22-23**
- 5) NOT something to be afraid of.

Natural talents and personality traits are important human resources we all have. These are not the same as spiritual gifts which are given by sovereign choice, by the Holy Spirit:

- at the time we become Christians, as well as
- when God wants to accomplish a new work.

SPIRITUAL GIFTS ARE ... Powerful, supernatural enablements given so we may serve God more effectively in the world and in the church.

- Every Christian has at least one spiritual gift, many receive more than one gift. In the New Testament, there are no distinctions between "professional ministers" (clergy/priest) and "regular people" (laity).
- Spiritual gifts must be employed in the power of the Holy Spirit and not in the self-energy of the flesh in order to please God and bring positive results. (We work with God rather than just for God.)
- Evidence you may be operating in a spiritual gift: you can experience great joy, deep satisfaction, and a bit of excitement
